Detecting and reporting mismanagement

- As beneficiaries of state policies and services, citizens experience the effects of mismanagement, resource deviations and mishandling of public policies. Their active involvement in reporting these anomalies is critical when undertaking strategies aimed at granting transparency and effectiveness in state interventions. Fostering engagement through information disclosure, public hearings, anti-corruption campaigns and reporting mechanisms can actually prove effective.

Ensuring probity

- Preventing corruption calls for establishing procurement systems based on transparency, competition and objective criteria in decision-making, granting that public officials will abide the law. In order to work effectively, such systems must ensure citizen engagement, as raising public awareness regarding the existence, causes and threat posed by corruption can lead to strengthened strategies to mitigate it.
